

# Provincial Commissioner's Commendation

- *A similar 'Protea' to the one awarded for long service by the Province, but with a different colour background and an "A" for "Award" in place of the "5" or "10" would be worn on the uniform.*
- *Lay persons receive a certificate.*
- *The awards can be awarded at any time of the year.*

## Requirements Scouters (uniformed):

1. Hold a warrant for at least two years as a Scouter in a Troop or Pack during the period in which they achieved a Bronze Pack or Troop Star Award
2. Have played a constructive role in the Group and District.
3. Encouraged the Scouts or Cubs to participate in District & Provincial events through motivation and his/her own example
4. If the Pack is smaller than 24 or the Troop is smaller than 36, have increased the Pack or Troop size by at least 20% or up to these numbers.
5. Shows he/she is promoting the aims of the movement.
6. Shows that the "Scout Values" are part of his/her life.
7. Be recommended (by submission to the Provincial Headquarters) by any uniform or lay member as a worthy recipient for consideration by the Provincial Commissioner.

## Requirements Lay Members (Non-uniformed):

1. Have served as a lay adult leader for at least three years in any capacity in the Movement.
2. Have played a constructive role in the level in which they are active.
3. Encouraged the Parents and other Lay Members to participate in and support Group, District, Regional, Provincial or National events through motivation and his / her own example.
4. Have assisted in the proper functioning and growth of the lay committee and its functions at the level he / she is involved in.
5. Shows he / she is promoting the Aims of the Movement.
6. Shows that the Values of Scouting (Fundamental Principles) are a part of his / her life.
7. Be recommended (by written submission to Provincial Headquarters) by any uniformed or lay member as a worthy recipient for consideration by the Provincial Commissioner.
