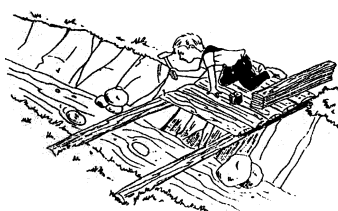
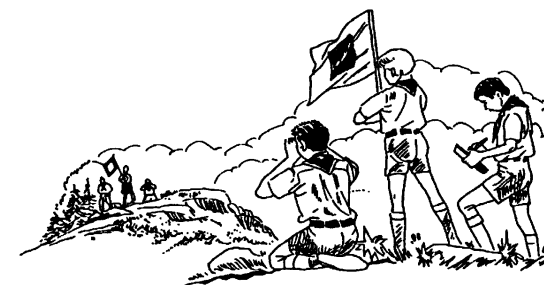

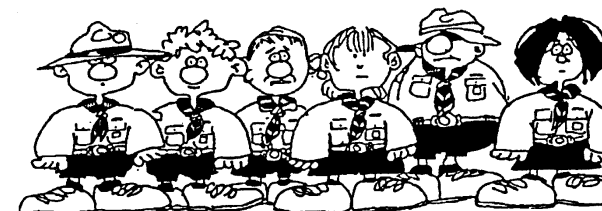

- NB.
- In Competitions Group 1 - Troops may only gain points from two of the three competitions mentioned. Either Rayner and Gordons or Rayner and Seamanship or Gordons and Seamanship.
 - In Competitions Group 2 - Troops may only gain points from two of the three competitions mentioned. Either Upton and a Regatta or Quin and a Regatta or two Regattas
 - Under the development section, written proof of assistance and programmes must be submitted by date to be determined each year.
