1st Claremont Centenary 2008

I'm sure you will be pleased to know that 2008 is 1st Claremont's 100th birthday – and it's a particularly special centenary, because we're the oldest Scout Group in South Africa.

The purpose of this letter is to get in contact with our hundreds of former members, so that you can be involved our centenary celebrations. In outline our plans for the centenary are as follows:

- On Saturday the 1st of March 2008, we will hold a celebration for present and former Scouts and families, at the 1st Claremont Scout Hall in Bowwood Road.
- The Scouts themselves will have an expedition to the Orange River and Northern Cape from 21 to 30 March 2008.
- We are putting together a centenary publication with photos and stories from the last century of Scouting at 1st Claremont.
- We are renovating the stage as a "Centenary Room" and also looking at several other repairs and improvements around the hall.

Attend our Centenary celebrations

First and foremost, we would love to see you at the 100th birthday celebration!

The celebrations will take place on the afternoon and evening of Saturday 1 March 2008 at the 1st Claremont Scout Hall, 17 Bowwood Road, Claremont. The Scouts will be camping in the grounds on Saturday, and there will be displays of photos, logbooks etc, so this part will be an "open day". There will be a formal get-together in the early evening, most likely followed by a campfire. Former Scouts are invited to stay on to join us around the campfire, if you would like to join the Scouts singing loudly and not necessarily tunefully.

This is also a great opportunity to arrange a reunion for a smaller group of former Scouts. If you would like to do this, let us know.

These will be available on a CD-ROM together with photos of the Scouts in action over the years.

If you have Scout stories you would like to tell, or memorabilia or photographs to donate or lend us for inclusion in our centenary publication or display at the centenary event, please let us know.

Contribute to our centenary fund

We believe that a number of former 1st Claremont Scouts would like to mark the occasion by assisting financially – putting something back – and we have therefore started a centenary fund. If you would like to donate, please do so using the donation form.

The aims of the fund are as follows:

- We want to ensure that no Scout misses a camp or other Scout event for financial reasons, and the Scouts' centenary trip to the Orange River and Northern Cape in March is no exception.
- The stage is being renovated as a Centenary Room, with structural repairs to the roof, installation of a ceiling, improved lighting, painting, and so on.
- Equipment is always in need of replacing – for instance, several of our current tents have done 20 years of service and need to be replaced at a cost of around R5000 each.
- We are very fortunate to have our own hall filled with Scouting tradition, but old buildings are expensive to maintain. Whether it is the roof, the electrics, the plumbing, the fences, painting, or simply maintaining the grounds, there is always more work to do than our bank account will allow. We would like the hall and grounds to be in good shape for our centenary.
