You are required to submit ONE COPY of your magazine / newsletter with this form, or a printout of the front page of your website. The envelope should be addressed to H V Marsh Award, South African Headquarters, PO Box 2434, Clareinch. 7740. It must arrive no later than 30 October. (Alternately reach Area Headquarters by 15 October and they will forward it to SAHQ by 30 October)

These entries will be evaluated by the judges under the following headings (all of equal importance):

- *Pleasure to read* – interesting, varied, challenging, stylish (not just factual reporting)
- *Pleasure to write* – produced as a pleasure, not a chore; contributions from a wide range within Group)
- *Information access* – Scouter names, addresses, phone numbers, future dates, badge successes.
- *Layout* – Page design, balance of text and illustration, legibility, general attractiveness.
- *Youth involvement* – Patrol / Six reports, local cartoons, individual comments and stories.

Those print entries considered to be in the running for the H V Marsh Award itself will be requested by the judges to submit the remaining issues published during the year. A minimum of 4 issues per year, with at least 8 A5 pages (or 4 A4 pages) to each, is required to qualify for this award, or a website with updates at least once a quarter, consisting of enough material to fill at least 4 A4 pages printed. The judges may, at their discretion, bestow a Silver or Gold standard certificate on a magazine / newsletter or website which does not meet these criteria, but such a publication will not be eligible for the Award itself. (So at least 4 issues during the year is your target)
