

Functions of the Rover Crew Leader

1. Take responsibility for the total WELFARE OF THE CREW adhering to all provisions in Policy, Organisation and Rules (PO&R) pertaining to the duties, responsibilities and functions of a Crew Leader.
2. Ensure that each new member understands and acknowledges the Aims, Methods, Promise and Law of the Scout Association.
3. Ensure that Crew activities are conducted in accordance with the spirit of the Scout Association and lead to growth and development of each individual.
4. Represent the Crew in Group, District, Area events and or meetings as applicable.
5. Support and encourage support for Group/s, District/s and Area activities for Cubs, Scouts, Rovers and where possible, other members of the Association.
6. Hold monthly Crew meetings and follow the Rules and Customs of Rovering.
7. Ensure full records are kept of members, activities and finances within the Crew.
8. Be enthusiastic, committed and set an example to others by living up to the Scout Law and Promise.
